Properties

Lecol PVAC glue is a quick polyvinylacetate based glue and has a high shear strength. Lecol PVAC glue corresponds to the requirements of Class Norm EN 204.

The glue should applied at room temperature (20 °C) to the groove from end to end. Press the panels together firmly to ensure a tight fit. Use a wooden block to prevent damage to the tongue.

The open time of Lecol PVAC glue is approx 5-7 minutes, depending on the temperature.

The average drying time of the glue is about 30 minutes. Excess glue should be removed immediately with a towel, before it dries.
