The subfloor as well as the room climate conditions must meet the requirements of the applicable standards and data sheets. Subfloors must be permanently dry, solid, level, free from cracks, dirt and adhesion-inhibiting substances. Use a suitable mechanical procedure to remove separating layers.

WAKOL D 3045 Special Primer is intended for use on smooth, dense subfloors. On absorbent subfloors, use WAKOL D 3003 Dispersion Primer, WAKOL D 3004 Primer Concentrate or WAKOL PU 280 Polyurethane Primer, WAKOL PU 235 Polyurethane Primer or WAKOL MS 330 Silane Primer. Refer to the respective data sheets for the areas of application and drying times.

When using WAKOL D 3045 Special Primer on old waterproof adhesive residues (only on cement screeds or non-absorbent subfloors such as mastic asphalt), the subfloor must be dust-free. In areas without adhesive residues it is important to ensure a sufficient adhesive bond of the primer.

Usage

Stir the container well before using. Apply the primer on the subfloor using a WAKOL Primer Roller or a velour or foam roller, without letting the substance pool. Complete subsequent levelling work after the primer has completely dried; pay careful attention to drying times above.
